The clinic will take place in an indoor arena, with all work "in-hand." The clinic is limited to 20 participants, so register now to reserve your space. If you are not a member of the Colorado Driving Society and wish for more information and the 2012 calendar of events, please indicate so on the registration form.

Parking is limited, so "trailer pool" if you can. Drive behind the arena and park in designated areas.

A continental breakfast will be provided from 9:30 am to 10:00 am. Bring your own lunch, a chair, proper shoes and gloves for the clinic.

This clinic will introduce your horse to a variety of stimuli which will act as building blocks during the day. Items that may be used are flags, flares, plastic, tape, balloons, noisy objects, sound conditioning, bridge, squeeze lines, and more. Sharron will use a task-by-task progression to clarify communication and trust between horse and handler. This philosophy allows a horse of any age to accept guidance and safety when the unexpected happens, or when fear and uncertainty come into the environment.

Should you wish to introduce a young horse to the clinic, we invite you to do so. Remember that their attention span is short and curiosity high, and that they may need extra reassurance in the form of breaks, snacks, and approval from you as a handler.

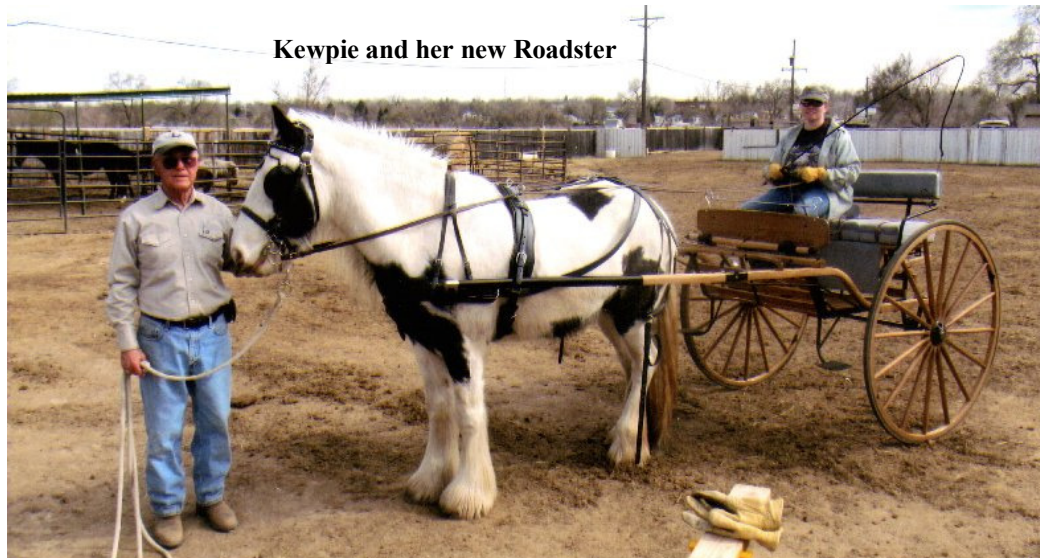
