## Picnic Drive, Saturday, August 18 Chatfield State Park

We're looking forward to seeing old friends and making new ones this year at the Chatfield State Park Picnic Drive. This is a wonderful place to drive roads and bridges as well as the Highline Canal. The last few years have blessed us with great weather and that always makes driving so much more enjoyable. Everyone "come as you are" and no frills necessary.

The picnic/drive location is at the Plum Creek Picnic area. (Note: Do not go to the Plum Creek Nature area) Parking is ample. For those of you with large rigs it is best to arrive early for best parking availability. Picnic tables are near by and under large shade trees. Potty is close. Plan to drive about 10:00 and potluck about 12:30. Bring a dish to share. No horse water is available so bring your own.

Directions: Take Santa Fe (Hwy 85) to Titan Pkwy and go west to Roxborough Park Rd. Go north on Roxborough Park Rd past the Highline Canal Trailhead to the Chatfield State Park east guard entrance. (\$7.00 daily or state parks pass) After the guard station stay right and follow the road until you see the STOP sign. Lake is directly in front of you. Turn right to the "Picnicking" area. this is a $1 / 4$ mile long road to the Plum Creek Picnic area.

From the north:
Take I-25 south to exit 158, Baptist Rd. Go east on Baptist Rd. It will turn into Hodgen Rd. Hodgen Rd will cross over Hwy 83. Continue on Hodgen Rd until it ends (about 10 more miles from HWY 83).
Turn right onto Eastonville Rd .8 mi
Take first left onto Sweet Rd 1.3 mi
Turn left onto Elbert RD/CO 2171.8 mi
Turn right onto Hopper Rd 2.3mi
Turn left onto Ranch Hand Rd .1 mi
Take the 1st left onto Oak Brush Loop . 2 mi
$\mathbf{2 n d}^{\text {nd }}$ House on left - Red Barn and Arena

From the south:
Take I-25 north to Woodmen Rd. East on Woodmen Rd. till it intersects with HWY24
Take HWY 24 northeast to Bradshaw Rd (Peyton Post Office on left) 13.5 mi
Turn left onto Bradshaw Rd. 4.8 mi
Turn left onto Hopper Rd 6 mi
Take the 1st right onto Ranch Hand Rd . 1 mi
Take the 1st left onto Oak Brush Loop . 2 mi
$\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ House on left - Red Barn and Arena
